Crowds enjoy 'Out There' experience

Giant insects, cavemen and a 60ft robot took over Great Yarmouth for Britain's largest circus festival. Organisers said the Out There Festival – now in its fifth year – was the most ambitious yet, and drew

thousands of curious visitors to St George's Park. Menacing creatures with black mohawks pounded drums around the park, clowns pedalled towering unicycles and athletic cavemen captured people's imagination on the wheel of death. Joe Mackintosh, director of Seachange Arts, said: "People are

sitting up and taking notice as it's the biggest circus festival in the UK."
